



Minibus Driver

S-Factor Academy's athletes are keen competitors at fixtures far and wide. We have a list of fixtures we encourage our athletes to attend all year round, many they will attend and participate in independently and some competitions we attend as a club.

For all competitions that we attend as a club we endeavour to provide transport to ensure our members cultivate a team spirit and rapport during the journey and can prep with their coaches. The athletes find this a fun and bonding experience.

Given the number of annual fixtures we list, we need a core group of minibus drivers who can drive our minibuses to and from these fixtures.

Requirements:

- You must hold a full UK driving Licence with class D1 (or PCV licence)
- You must be punctual
- You should be friendly and approachable
- Should have some experience of driving passengers
- Be DBS checked (if not, we can arrange for this)
- Be available for occasional fixtures – probably no more than 5 per year, on rotation with other minibus drivers. All fixtures will be notified way in advance so you will have them diarized.

What you will do:

- Collect the minibus in advance from our partner (either a local school or Lewisham Community Transport Scheme)
- Establish directions to the fixture location ahead of time (or have access to a sat nav)
- Be prepared to attend the fixture for its duration (if far away)
- Escort the athletes back to the pick up point (typically Ladywell Arena)

How much time will it take?

This will take roughly 4-6 hours for each fixture (includes collecting the minibus, driving to location, staying at the fixture and driving back to base.)

What you'll get out of it:

This is a fun role! You will get to know the athletes over time as you see the same athletes competing over different fixtures. You will watch a day of track and field, and you will get to know the coaches personally too. This is a way to immerse yourself in a core part of what S-Factor does.
